Registration and payment are both available at SOMHA.com. Online payment can be made in full or an installment option is available upon check out. An initial payment will be processed at the time of registration and then 2 additional payments will automatically be processed on August 1st and September 1st. If an installment payment is declined, the registrar will contact you with the process to pay the outstanding balance.

Players trying out for Junior or Zone teams must still notify the Registrar BEFORE July 1, to be eligible for the reduced registration rate.

Players who wish to play in SOMHA, coming with a Residential Waiver, must provide the completed form prior to any participation in any SOMHA on or off ice events. Players with waivers who wish to tryout for a SOMHA Rep team will be required to register online and pay the non-refundable tryout fee. If selected for the Rep team, to secure the reduced registration rate, the full registration fees will be due immediately. The registrar will provide instructions on how to make payment.

Players new to SOMHA will be required to provide a copy of the player's birth certificate prior to participating in any association on or off ice activities. You may mail a copy to our Registrar at the address below. Do not send the original. Birth certificate copies may be scanned and emailed to the Registrar.

Attention USA Players: All players residing outside of BC must complete and submit a Declaration of Residence Form with their Registration form. A DOR will be provided in all USA

Player's Registration package. Beginning in the 2015-2016 season, players who are residents of any country other than Canada must purchase their own primary insurance coverage. Failure to do so could result in a situation where no insurance coverage is in place.

HOCKEY CANADA INSURANCE WILL NOT RESPOND UNLESS PRIMARY COVERAGE IS IN PLACE.

All parents of registered players are expected to help with their team's home tournament as well as other team events. This is a fundamental part of being a minor hockey parent.
